DEFINITION OF TRUCK DRIVER FOR LOWBED TRAILER – EQUIPMENT HAULER JOB

Operates heavy equipment in compliance with the company operating safety policies and procedures.

SUPERVISION RECEIVED AND EXERCISED

Receives supervision from the Demolition Director of Operations.

EXAMPLES OF ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Drives truck with low-boy trailer with equipment to and from garage or storage site to work site.
- Load and unload equipment
- Conducts routine equipment inspections and preventative maintenance on equipment; maintains accurate records.
- Follow appropriate standard operating procedures as guideline for operating and maintaining vehicle.
- Performs other duties as assigned.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Knowledge of:

- Safety regulations and precautions pertaining to vehicle use
- Safe and proper use of assigned equipment.

Ability to:

- Ability to travel to various job sites as required.
- The ability to understand and follow instructions from Supervisors.
- Ability to follow all safety instructions.
- Ability to report to work on time and as scheduled.

TYPICAL WORKING CONDITIONS

- Work is performed both indoors and outdoors. Incumbent drives on surface streets and operates equipment on unpaved surfaces.
- Worker occasionally works past normal office hours to complete assignments.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Requires the mobility to perform vehicle operating duties.
- The Truck Driver position is a physically strenuous and demanding job.

- Previously worked in a construction or demolition environment
- Previously worked as a truck driver for low-bed haulers for five (5) years working with construction equipment

- High school diploma or GED equivalent.

- OSHA Certified is plus

Additional Requirements

- Possession of a valid and clean USA, New Jersey or New York CDL “A” operator’s license with medical card.
- Must be hardworking and reliable for projects in Northern NJ and Lower NY State.
- Hours are full time
- Some travel throughout the state of NJ, NY State, PA and CT.
- Responsible and willing to work overtime if needed
- Must be willing to submit to a drug screening test.
- Must be a legal resident or citizen of the USA.
- Must have reliable transportation, and a phone are required.
- Must speak, read, and understand English.
